## **DECSIONS:**

- The attached revised SUFC Priorities was approved by the working group. It is being reviewed
  by the SUFC Steering Committee and will be distributed to the full SUFC membership for
  approval prior to July 10<sup>th</sup>.
- This Priorities document is a stand-alone platform piece that provides guidance and a
  foundational reference/springboard. The WG/SUFC can refer back to this as needed. It is not an
  external document. Immediate inner-circle audiences include: NUCFAC, U&CF Program/DC,
  NASF Urban Cmte, Beth Larry network+). Other external materials will be developed as needed
  and crafted without jargon and carefully messaged.
- The platform document should be revisited and reviewed annually by the WG.
- The WG decided it was not necessary to prioritize the 10 issue areas and recognized the marked progress this document reflects (including identifying common areas of interest from diverse stakeholders, categorization and sub-categorization, formalizing working group). Now that this foundation has been established the WG can focus on short and longer-term goals and action.
- Moving into next phase of work, WG will compile issues of interest, draft specific goals, and build out implementation strategies (reflecting timeline, , audiences, resources+)
